Annie would thrive in a loving home committed to her rehabilitation. A home with labrador experience preferred. A ground-floor property or home without many steps and a secure garden would be beneficial and ideally close to Vita where she will have her surgery.



Is there any management required?

Annie will require rehabilitation, ongoing recall training and weight loss management and investment in her ongoing development.

Annie has lived with another dog previously. She would need careful introduction to cats and other small animals as she may chase initially.



Useful information to know:

Annie is very friendly with children but can occasionally jump up, mouth when excited, pull strongly on lead, and scavenges if given the opportunity. A home who would foster her through her surgery and then adopt her once she is recovered would be preferable.
